DeVos Place On-site Recycling and Composting Guide

Please help us divert as much as possible from the landfill during NHC. Your efforts are a crucial part of the success of the conference's sustainability program, especially during set up and tear down. There will be single stream recycling, compost and waste recovery bins throughout the venue to ensure the proper disposal of materials.

What Can Be Recycled:

- Cardboard
- Hard Plastics #1- #6
- Clean Paper
- Aluminum Cans
- Bottles

e.g., bottles, magazines, newspapers, packaging

Please make sure to clean plastics of residues prior to recycling. We can recycle plastic film/wrap/bags if they are collected in bulk for recycling.

What Can Be Composted

- All Food Scraps
- #7 PLA Products
- Soiled Paper Products
- Compostable Cups
- Compostable Utensils
- Paper Plates, Napkins
- Wax Paper Products
- Soiled Cardboard

e.g., compostable Eco Products cups, paper plates with all of its food, soiled napkins

What Goes in the Trash:

- All wrappers
- Individual Plastic Bags
- Styrofoam
- Plastic Plates & Utensils

e.g., chip bags, packaging foam, Ziploc bags, plastic cutlery
